- i. P-BUSA-01-02-AA-2015-2016 (Substantive Program Modification, BSBA)
 1. Discussion – BSBA at MGA and its predecessors has historically been a BS in IT, but the degree has been moving toward a traditional BSBA. This program is consistent with other schools of Business, and consistent with AACSB
 2. Student Learning Outcomes in BUSA-01 will read:
 1. analyze and discuss situations involving a global environment and diversity issues,
 2. solve complex problems using quantitative and qualitative data.
 3. analyze cases containing ethical issues, identify possible courses of action, and discuss the potential outcomes of those actions.
 4. understand and be able to apply core concepts in business effectively.
 5. communicate effectively in both written and oral formats.
 3. BUSA-02, the addition of the General Business track in the BSIT, will go into effect in the Fall 2015 catalog, rather than the Spring 2016.
